**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD
WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

**SETTING SUNNY HILL CENSUS NUMBER
FOR PROPOSED LICENSED BED CAPACITY**

WHEREAS, since the closing of First Avenue for renovations nearly five years ago, Sunny Hill has experienced an average resident census of approximately 202, and

WHEREAS, since the opening of the completed renovated avenue in early 2008, Sunny Hill has experienced an average resident census of 215, and

WHEREAS, since that time Sunny Hill's census continues to climb, averaging 220 for the better part of 2008 due to the ease of filling available beds after the certification of all beds as Medicare skilled, with a maximum of 238 available beds for occupancy, and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of Sunny Hill's Administrator and County Executive's Office that the proposed licensed bed capacity be set at 238, and

WHEREAS, the Public Health & Safety Committee concurs and recommends to the full County Board that Sunny Hill's proposed licensed bed capacity be set at 238.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Will County Board hereby sets the proposed licensed bed capacity for Sunny Hill Nursing Home at 238.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Will County Board hereby directs the Will County Executive and Sunny Hill Administrator to take the necessary administrative steps with the State of Illinois to have Sunny Hill's licensed bed capacity be set at 238; and report back to the Public Health & Safety Committee when all Will County documentation has been filed with the appropriate administrative agencies and when notice that the revised licensed bed capacity has received all necessary approvals.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Preamble of this Resolution is hereby adopted as if fully set forth herein. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law.

After carefully reviewing the bids that were received for the Pharmacy Services bid for Sunny Hill Nursing Home of Will County, it is my recommendation that the County of Will award the one year service contract (with the potential of two – one year renewal periods) to the following bidder to cover all required consultation services, equipment needs and pharmaceutical needs of the residents served by Sunny Hill Nursing Home of Will County:

**UNITED SCRIPPS
865 North Ellsworth Avenue
Villa Park, Illinois 60181**

This award will provide Sunny Hill with a different vendor than we currently use. The following criteria was studied and compared carefully to determine our recommendation (see additional documentation):

- ❖ Hourly costs to be charged to the facility for required consultants
- ❖ Per diem (daily) costs for resident basic pharmaceutical needs that cover non-specialized medical conditions
**United Scripps per diem of \$28.00 per resident is all-inclusive, meaning that this pharmacy's list of covered medications is more extensive than PharMerica, whose per diem cost is \$20.84. Currently, though the per diem cost from PharMerica is \$20.84, the average cost to Sunny Hill for a resident is \$38.00 per day.
- ❖ Equipment provision at no cost to the facility (including the equipment and software to support an electronic MAR/TAR medication administration system)
- ❖ Pharmacy ability to credit the facility 100% for all unused medication due to their ability to provide facility (at no cost) a tamper-proof medication distribution system.
- ❖ Pharmacy ability to locate any medication needed using their relationship with local hospitals and pharmacy (Walgreens)
- ❖ Improved method of prior authorization for Medicare Part D residents
