***Amends the State Prompt Payment Act – Article V of IL Public Aid Code***

WHEREAS, there is pending in the General Assembly House Bill 237, which amends the State Prompt Payment Act to provide that any bill submitted under Article V of the Illinois Public Aid Code approved for payment must be paid or the payment issued to the payee within 30 days (now, 60 days) after receipt of a proper bill or invoice, and, if payment is not issued to the payee within this 30-day period, an interest penalty of 2.0% (now, 1.0%) of any amount approved and unpaid shall be added for each month or fraction thereof after the end of this 30-day period, until final payment is made, and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Committee has been diligently monitoring legislation affecting Will County, and strongly **SUPPORTS the concepts of HB237**, as written today.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Will County Board hereby **SUPPORTS the concepts of HB237**, which amends the State Prompt Payment Act to provide that any bill submitted under Article V of the Illinois Public Aid Code approved for payment must be paid or the payment issued to the payee within 30 days (now, 60 days) after receipt of a proper bill or invoice, and, if payment is not issued to the payee within this 30-day period, an interest penalty of 2.0% (now, 1.0%) of any amount approved and unpaid shall be added for each month or fraction thereof after the end of this 30-day period, until final payment is made.
